Single Non-Business graduate students must provide evidence in the (minimum) amount of \$26,011 to meet expenses for a calendar year at Indiana University. This amount does not include the cost of Summer Session tuition.

**Dependent Expenses**

A married student must add \$5,079 for a spouse, \$5,079 for a first child, with or without spouse, and \$3,494 each additional dependent. Please note that University-sponsored Health and Accident Insurance is required for all international students in F and J status and their dependents.
