Single graduate nursing graduate students must provide evidence in the minimum amount of \$33,585 to meet estimated expenses for a calendar year at Indiana University. This amount does not include the cost of Summer Session tuition.

Dependent Expenses

A married student must add \$5,079 for a spouse, \$5,079 for a first child, with or without spouse, and \$3,494 for each additional dependent. Please note that University-sponsored health and accident insurance is required for all international students in F and J status and their dependents.
