Single artist and performer diploma students must provide evidence in the minimum amount of \$26,888 to meet estimated expenses for a calendar year at Indiana University. This amount does not include the cost of tuition for a student starting in a Summer session.

Dependent Expenses

A married student must add \$5,502 for a spouse, \$5,502 for a first child, with or without spouse, and \$3,682 for each additional dependent. Please note that University-sponsored health and accident insurance is required for all international students in F and J status and their dependents.

A. Tuition and Fees

Artist and performer diploma students pay \$760 per credit hour. The amounts indicated below include Technology, Student Activity, International Student Services, and Repair & Rehabilitative fees.
