New Apply IU Application

Students are now able to complete one application and direct it to all IU campuses that interest them.

This makes it easier, faster, and more affordable to apply to any Indiana University campus!

Students can access the new Apply IU App from a web browser by visiting:

https://admissions.iusb.edu/ apply/apply-to-iu-southbend.html

The application fee for Apply IU typically ranges from \$35 to \$65, depending on the campus and program students choose.

IU accepts NACAC, SAT, or other high school waivers that ar based upon economic need.

IU South Bend's application fee

remains \$35 and can be paid by credit card or eCheck.

First-time freshmen can apply to IU by submitting:

- One application which can be directed to any campus
- One application fee (each term you apply)
- One copy of your official transcript(s) and official test scores
- One essay (if applying to IU Bloomington or IUPUI)

Deadlines vary among IU campuses.

Students are able to submit a new application to an additional campus and use previously submitted information.

New Degree Programs

• Vera Z. Dwyer College of Health Sciences is adding a new program in **Speech Language Pathology**. With the bachelor's degree, students can become an assistant to a Speech Language Pathologist, behavior management technician, social service assistant or gerontology aid

Indiana has a greater than average need for speech language pathologists so job prospects in our state are plentiful.

- The Bachelor's degree in **Clinical Laboratory Science** prepares students for work in the clinical laboratory setting, including hematology, immunology, microbiology, chemistry, phlebotomy, molecular diagnostics and blood banking.
- IU South Bend's Bachelor of Science in Health Science degree with a concentration in **Sport and Exercise Science** is designed for students interested in careers related to health and fitness. Students majoring in Sport and Exercise Science can be certified as Exercise Physiologists, Strength and Conditioning Specialists, and more.

Admissions on the Road


IU South Bend admission counselors travel all over the Michiana area for:

Out-of-State Scholarships

The Midwest Student Exchange

Program, or MSEP, is a multistate tuition reciprocity program. Through the MSEP, public institutions agree to charge students no more than 150% of the in-state resident tuition rate for specific programs.

States that participate in MSEP:

- Illinois
- Indiana
- Kansas
- Michigan
- Minnesota
- Missouri
- Nebraska

- North Dakota
- Ohio
- Wisconsin

The Chancellor's Merit Award is

intended to promote the enrollment of high ability students at IU South Bend.

Recipients of the Award will pay 140% of the in-state resident tuition rate.

Requirements:

 Indiana House enacted HB 1402 and SB 590 prohibits students that are not U.S. Citizens or a qualified alien from receiving

- institutional scholarship funds
- Graduate from a U.S. high school or state recognized home school program with a college preparatory curriculum
- Have a minimum 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale
- SAT score of 1030 or ACT composite score of 20 or higher
- Be formally admitted without condition
