Single graduate nursing graduate students must provide evidence in the minimum amount of \$34,647 to meet estimated expenses for a calendar year at Indiana University. This amount does not include the cost of Summer Session tuition.

**Dependent Expenses**

A married student must add \$5,331 for a spouse, \$5,331 for a first child, with or without spouse, and \$3,541 for each additional dependent. Please note that University-sponsored health and accident insurance is required for all international students in F and J status and their dependents.
