**Estimated Expenses for the 2022-2023 Academic Year**  
**For a Single Undergraduate International (Out-of-State) Student**

A. Tuition and Fees (2 semesters)	\$21,499 (12 to 18 credits per semester)
B. Room and Board	\$10,396
C. Miscellaneous Expenses	<u>\$ 4,010</u>
Total	<u>\$35,905</u>

Single undergraduate students must provide evidence in the (minimum) amount of \$35,905 to meet estimated expenses for a calendar year at Indiana University. This amount does not include the cost of Summer Session tuition.

**Dependent Expenses**

A married student must add \$5,331 for a spouse, \$5,331 for a first child, with or without spouse, and \$3,541 for each additional dependent. Please note that University-sponsored health and accident insurance is required for all international students in F and J status and their dependents.

***Detail of Estimated Expenses for Fall & Spring Only\****

**A. Tuition and Fees**

Students pay a “banded” tuition rate each semester with the option to enroll in from 12 to 18 credits. Students in F-1 status must take a minimum of 12 credits each Fall and Spring Semester to maintain immigration status.
