Single social work graduate students must provide evidence in the (minimum) amount of \$28,587 to meet expenses for a calendar year at Indiana University. This amount does not include the cost of tuition for a student starting in a Summer session.

Dependent Expenses

A married student must add \$5,018 for a spouse, \$5,018 for a first child, with or without spouse, and \$3,229 each additional dependent. Please note that University-sponsored Health and Accident Insurance is required for all international students and their dependents.

8 credit hours per semester	\$7,633.50
16 credit hours per academic year	\$15,267
